We are asking all competing barista to share their talent with the audience, by **giving 20 minutes of their time to prepare drinks on the machine during the day** – after the event of course! We will ask for donations for the drinks, with all the proceeds going to Coffee Kids (www.coffeekids.org). We managed to raise £500 in 2009 - hopefully we can make even more this year! If you would like to bring additional ingredients to show off your signature drinks, please feel free.

The UK Chapter of the SCAE runs a number of events throughout the year to promote the SCAE Championships and promote barista skills, and will call upon the winners and finalists to assist with these events. Participation in these events would be done on a voluntary basis although expenses will be paid – we do hope you will be happy to help with this, and share your skills around!
